

COME HOME Neuroendocrine Lung Cancer (low and intermediate grade neuroendocrine carcinoma of the lung) Pathway v2 November 2013

Diagnostic Workup

1. Pathology Review (required for all patients)
2. History and Physical within one month of first visit (required for all patients)
3. CBC with differential, platelets, BUN, creatinine within one month of first visit (required for all patients)
4. Brain MRI or CT with contrast (symptomatic and/or Stage I or II)
5. PET-CT (optional)
6. Chest/abdominal CT (required unless PET done previously)
7. Bronchoscopy (required for all patients)
8. Smoking cessation counseling (required for all patients)
9. Assessment of mediastinal nodes (prior to surgery, if surgery performed)
10. Octreotide scan (optional)
